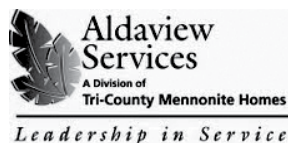

Aldaview Services, a division of Tri-County Mennonite Homes, began in 1979 and currently provides support to over 50 adults with a developmental disability. Support is based on the needs and goals of the individual and can range from residential supports such as apartment living, long term shared living and short stay respite, job training, job support, life skills training, and assisting with involvement in leisure/recreational activities.
